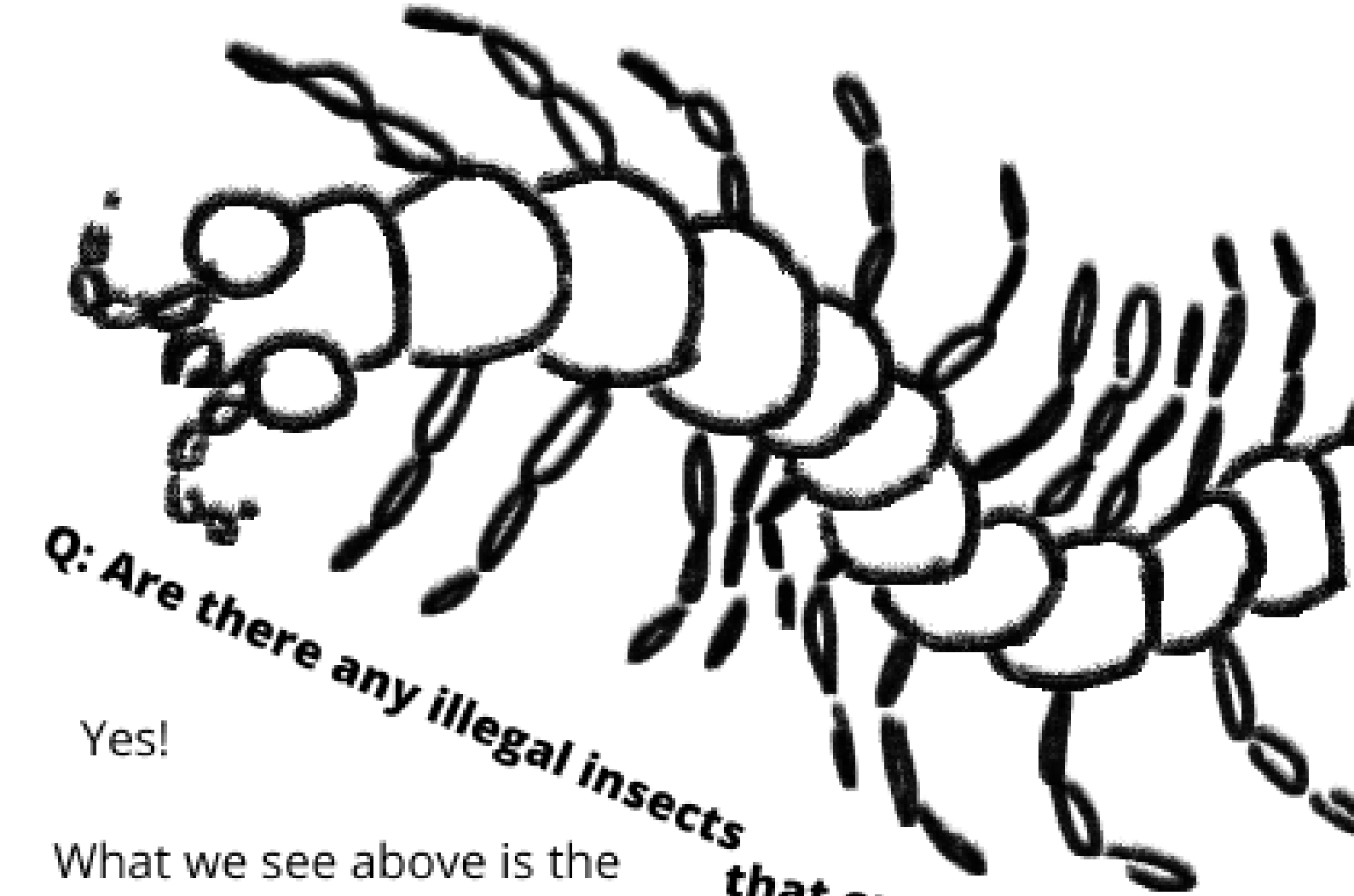
Q: What's up with this guy?

Q: Are there any illegal insects

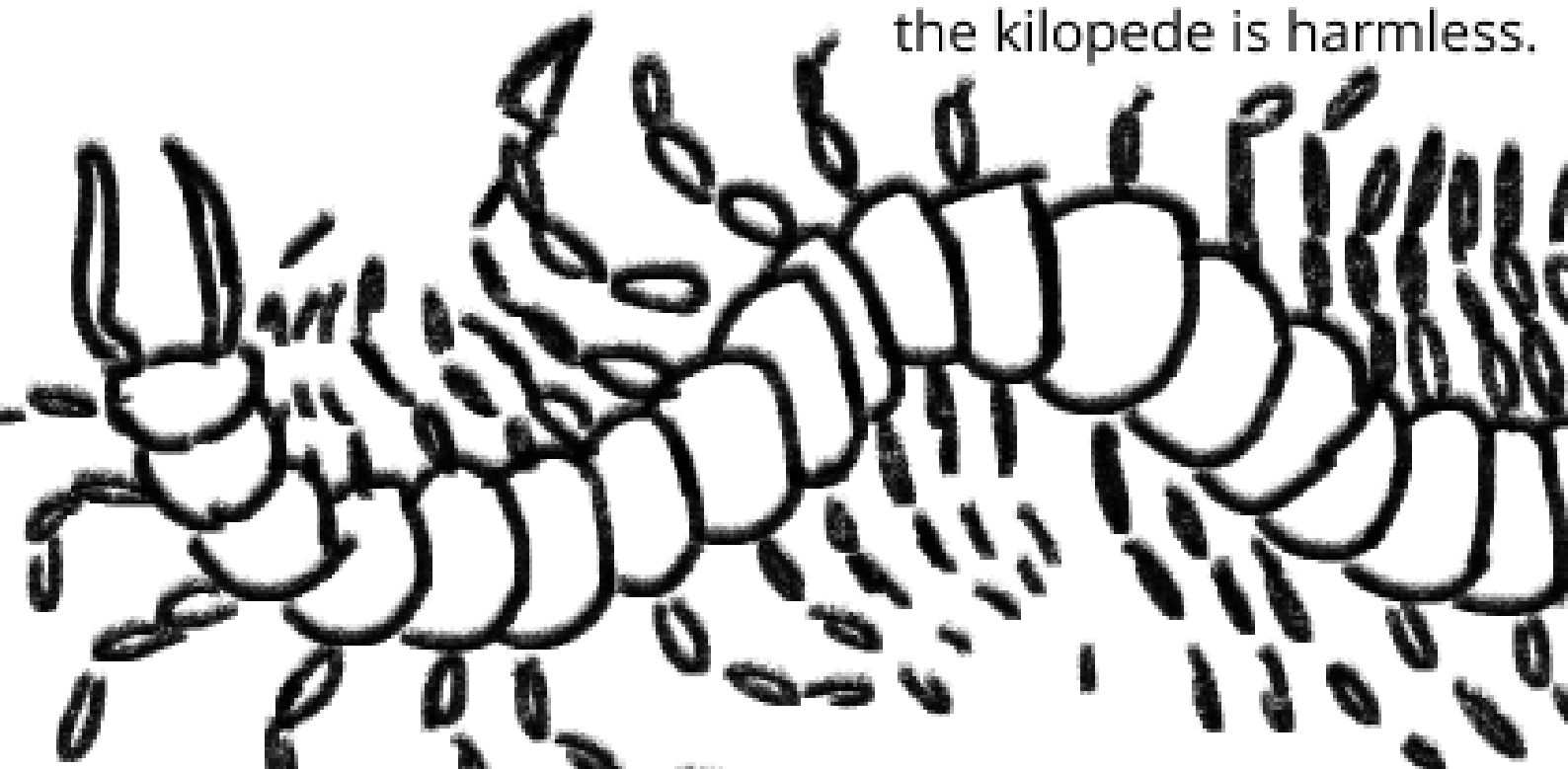
Yes!

(Hemaris Poseur)

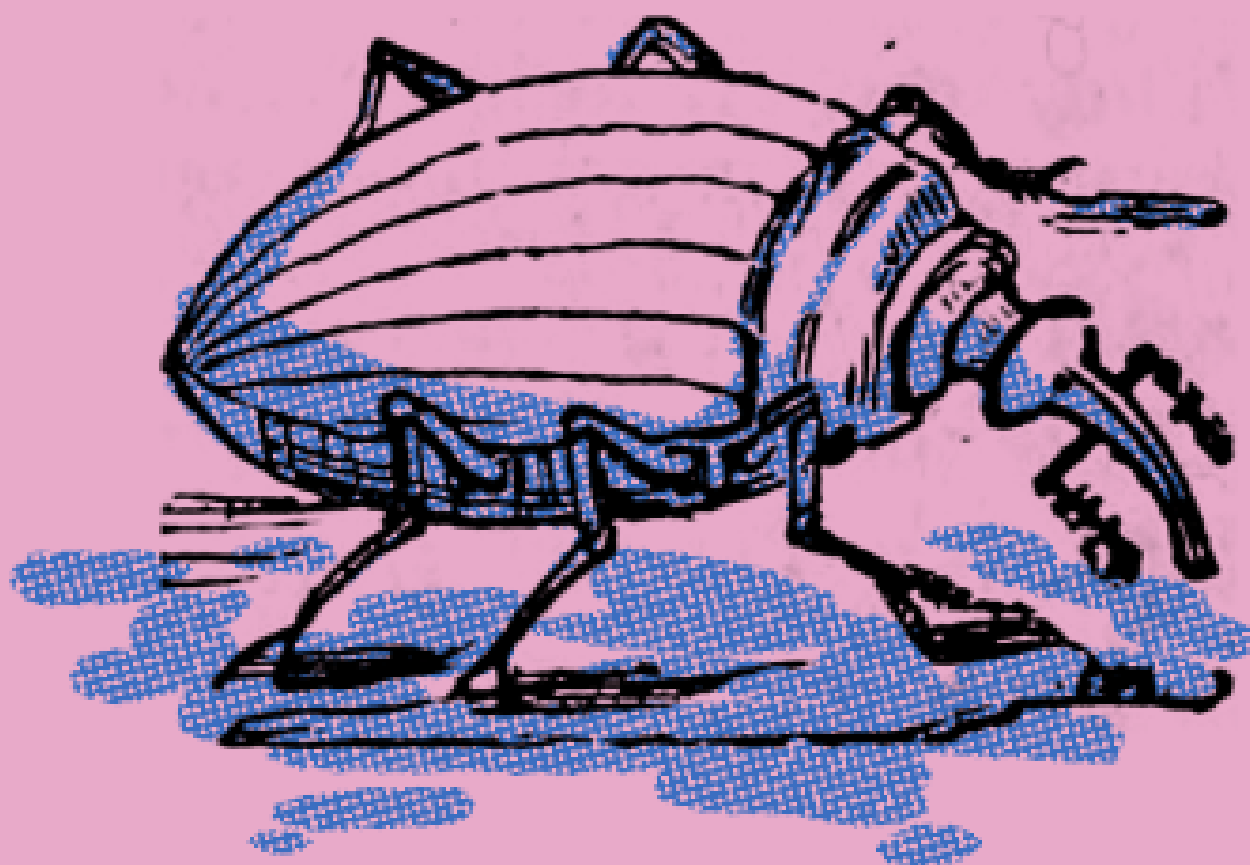
